"Is India becoming a Nation of Suicide States because of Globalization?" - Prof. Muzaffar H Assadi

Addressing the audience as a Key Note Speaker in the one day state level conference on "India's Path of development in the Era of Globalization" organized by Vidyavardhaka First Grade College, Prof. Assadi expressed his fear about the flourishing globalization.

However there is no clear-cut definition to understand globalization. We are not yet certain whether it is a process or is it a phase of progress or what kind of India is it creating, he said. Tracking the path of globalization Prof. Assadi said, that it had begun as early as people started to migrate and not probably in 1990's when modernity started in India.

Especially in India, where we expected socialism with the aim of social equality, there had been a continuous clash between socialistic mindset and capitalism that crept into our nation which was unavoidable for development. Socialism created four revolution viz., Land reforms, Decentralization, Reservation and Green revolution but these reforms were never complete but it created sick states. Inequality was created even by socialism.

Globalization beyond creating billionaires had certainly created a false notion, with new cultural practices and new trends it had made those who do not follow such practices to think themselves under developed or un-updated or even uncivilized and it is the root cause for farmers suicide and displacement in India. Furthermore it has collapsed the agrarian economy of India.
