Today at 11.30 am, the workshop was inaugurated by the college Principal, Dr.S.Marigowda. Dr.Ashwini S, Associate Professor and HOD of P.G. Centre, Dr. B.S. Harsha, Dr. Rajeshwari G.M, Smt.S. Poornima and Sri.Prashanth Kumar G, the faculties of P.G. Centre and Prof. N. Geetha, Placement Coordinator, VVFGC were present in the inaugural function.
