Presentation on NAAC Assessment and Accreditation process of Aided Colleges

UGC - Paramarsh 2019

- University Grants Commission (Mandatory Assessment and Accreditation of higher Educational Institutions) Regulations 2012 were notified to make it mandatory for each Higher Education Institution to get accredited by the Accreditation Agency after passing out of two batches or six years, whichever is earlier. UGC has also set an ambitious target for itself that institutions should get accredited with a minimum score of 2.5 by the year 2022.
- To accomplish this target, UGC introduced a new initiative called "Paramarsh" in the year 2019 for mentoring the nonaccredited institutions.
- 167 Mentor Institutions have been approved so far under "Paramarsh" to mentor 936 non-accredited HEIs.





- · Prevents colleges from violating the rules.


