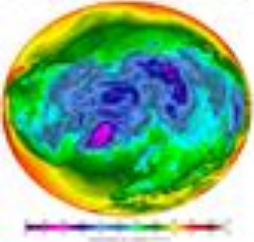

On 03-04-2024, a Special Lecture Series, 2023-24 in Association with IQAC and Department of Geography was organized in Vidyavardhaka First Grade College, Mysuru, at Shri.P.M Chikkaboraiah Hall. A burning issue was taken as the topic of this Special Lecture, “Climatical changes and its Management by the Students” by Dr. Jaganath Venkataramaiaha, Rtd Environmental Scientist, ISRO.

The key note speaker began this session through a mode of interaction with the students with reference to day to day activities. A person and his society should have an awareness, attitude, knowledge, skill, and readiness to take part can make any individual or the society to solve his or her, and it's problems. He opined that, ‘Science is a branch of study which makes every unknown individual to a known individual’. He said, ‘To perform any task with what I know is Science’. Science without application is useless so we should make use of solar panels, kitchen bio gas, compost manure, borewell recharge and rain water harvesting in our day to day lives. He encouraged the students to ask many questions and in return, students were motivated with brilliant answers and books were given as token of appreciation.

He gave a message to the audience to make use of steel plates, tumblers, and steel spoons as a tradition and custom, instead of plastic.
