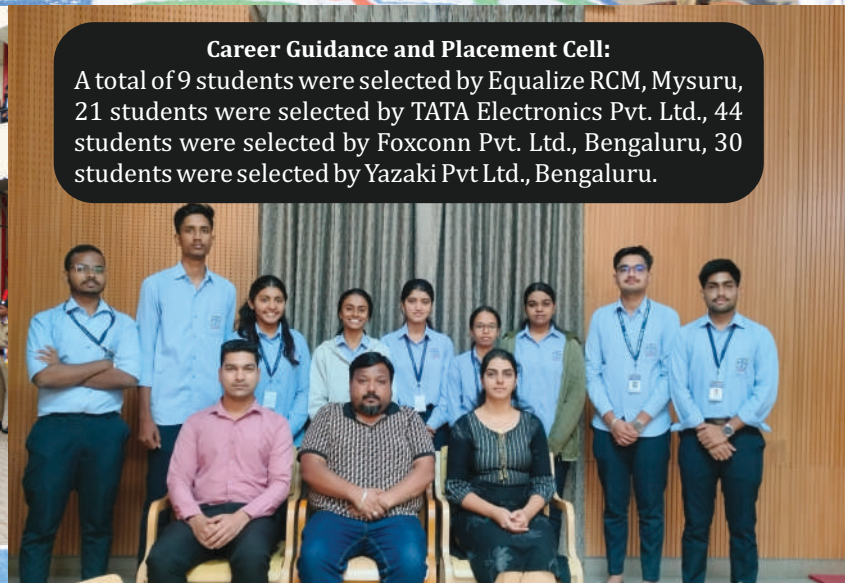
Co-Curricular Activities

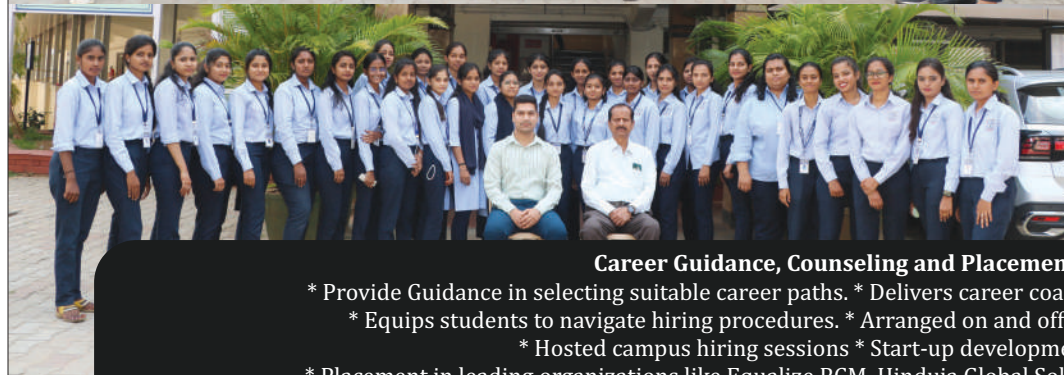


Scouts and Guides: The College has full-fledged Wing for Scouts and Guides. It is a voluntary non-political educational movement for young students to achieve

ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR BBA, BCOM, BA & BCA

1. Prospectus along with application forms for the relevant courses can be obtained from the office.
2. Filled in application forms along with necessary documents must be submitted before the last date or apply online through <https://uucms.karnataka.gov.in>
3. Parents should accompany the candidate at the time of admission.
4. The following documents have to be produced at the time of admission:
 - a) Original PUC Marks card and Photo copy of the same.
 - b) Transfer Certificate & Photo copy of the same.
 - c) Photo copy of Caste/Income Certificate.
 - d) One latest Passport size Photograph.
 - e) Photo copy of S.S.L.C. Marks card.
 - f) Adhaar card Photo copy.
5. Foreign students are required to produce the following documents along with the documents mentioned above:
 - a) AIDS Free Certificate (Medical Certificate)
 - b) Eligibility Certificate
 - c) Copies of Passport
 - d) Copies of VISA
 - e) Corona Free Medical Certificate
6. The students, who desire to withdraw their admission from the college, will forfeit all the fees paid by them.

ATTENDANCE

A student must compulsorily attend 75 percent of the classes conducted. A student who has attendance below the prescribed percentage will not be allowed to take the examination.

TESTS AND EXAMINATIONS

Periodical tests, examinations, viva-voce and group discussions will be conducted by the college as per the regulations of the University of Mysuru, which is compulsory to all the students. Abstaining from tests and examinations will be viewed seriously.

GENERAL RULES
